Through the innovative use of stereoscopic 3D LED technology on a colossal 75-foot screen, audiences will not only gaze into the masterpieces but, for the first time ever, look out from them. Guests can literally see the artist's brushstrokes as paintings come to life all around them.

More than just a feast for the eyes, Lasting Impressions the Immersive 3D Orchestra Experience is a delight for the ears too. The integration of live music performed by the **Fort Worth Symphony Orchestra**, coupled with custom lighting design, will further elevate the sensory experience, immersing guests in a symphony of sight and sound. Works by composers like Debussy and Ravel, French music, and impressionist-inspired songs with guest vocalist Adam Fisher will transport the audience back in time.
